Your Online Claim Form must be submitted **no later than February 16, 2020**

CLAIM FORM INSTRUCTIONS

Please read all the instructions and carefully complete the Online Claim Form so that your claim can be assessed as easily as possible.

- When completing the Online Claim Form:
 - You will be required to provide **one (1) government-issued piece of identification** that proves your legal name and date of birth in order for the Claims Administrator to efficiently authenticate your claim
 - If you are submitting **a claim on behalf of a Class Member** (for example, as trustee, executor, power of attorney, etc.), you will be required to provide proof of authority to legally act on the Class Member's behalf
 - **Supporting documentation** is not required to submit a claim – in the event that supporting documentation is needed to process your claim, the Claims Administrator will contact you and invite you to provide some documentation
 - A **copy of the claim submission** will be sent by email to the email address provided with the claim submission. Please keep this for your records and for future reference
 - **IMPORTANT:** The information you provide in your claim is a very important part of what will be considered when deciding whether to award you compensation, and if so, the amount of the compensation. If you need to make changes to any information in your claim submission after you have sent it to the Claims Administrator, please do so as soon as possible. **Examples of important changes include a change of address, corrections to any information provided, or any new information about your claim.**


